# CRITICAL SAFETY ITEMS

- Acquisition Management Concerns
  - Problems with unapproved sources, etc.
  - Brought to the attention of Joint Aeronautical Commanders Group (JACG)
- Concurrent with FSCAP efforts
  - Slightly different definitions
  - Different portions of the process
  - Two distinct programs proved confusing to users

# ACTIONS TAKEN

- Combined populations, definitions
- Issued tri-service instruction under JACG
  - Concentrates on full life-cycle
  - Establishes engineering role in identification of CSI/FSCAP
- Drafted revised FSCAP policy in DoD 4140.1-R, Materiel Management Regulation

## NEXT STEPS

- Clean up the coding of these items in FLIS
- Ensure approved sources, critical characteristics, etc. available for each item purchased
- Update publications as appropriate
- Communicate the need to identify and manage these critical items
- Ensure integrity of FSCAP coding maintained
